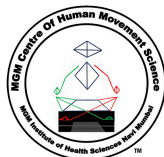

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## Guidelines for Abstract

- Language: ENGLISH.
- Submission through: email address provided.
- One-blinded & one non-blinded copy
- Submission only through the presenting author's email.
- The presenting author could be any author listed on the abstract.
- One abstract per presenting author.
- Only one presenting author per paper is permitted.
- Only the author/ co-authors may present the abstract; if no author is available, the accepted abstract will be withdrawn.
- Word limit: 300 words (excluding the title and information on authors).
- Registration is compulsory before submission.
- Submission Format: Microsoft Word document, 1.5 line spacing, 12-point font (Times New Roman), 1-inch margins on all sides.
- Only the presenting authors will receive a certificate of presentation.
- The Scientific Programme Committee's decisions are final.

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- 1. Title:** Clear, concise, and specific to the research topic (maximum 15 words).
- 2. Author Information:** Full name, institutional affiliation, and contact information for all authors. Underline the name of the presenting author. (Only the presenting author will receive the certificate.). Exclude this section in the blinded copy of the abstract.
- 3. Structure of Abstract:**
  - Introduction: Brief overview of the problem being addressed and its relevance to the category.
  - Objectives: State the research aims or clinical question.
  - Methodology: Provide a summary of the study design, population, data collection, and analysis methods.
  - Results: Mention the statistical tests used and the precise quantitative outcome.
  - Conclusion: Summarize the significance of the results and their implications for practice or research in the specific category.
- 4. Keywords:** 5-6 keywords
- 5. Ethical Compliance:** Ensure compliance with institutional ethical standards, and disclosure should be made in the abstract after the conclusion.

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
